Por ser um material versátil e higiênico o seu utilização é variada. As recomendações de uso do Silestone são em projetos, como:

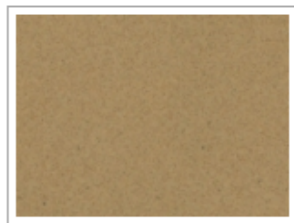
